Which took a lot of hands to make.

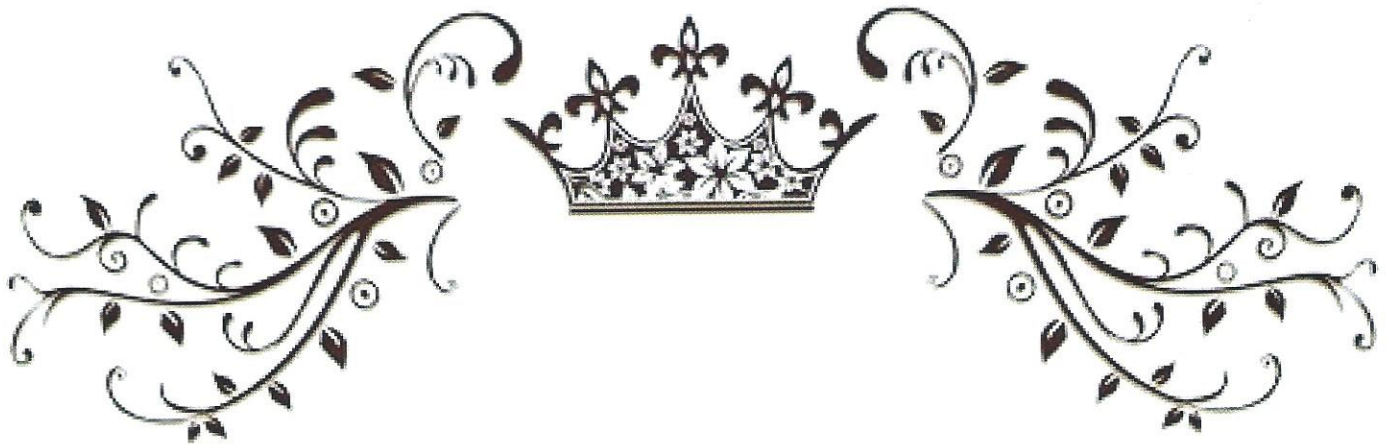
There is great beauty in your bright blue eyes

And many more days to come!

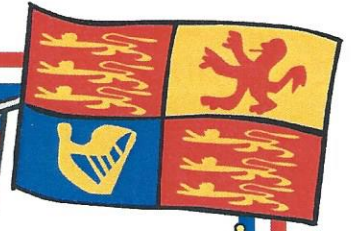

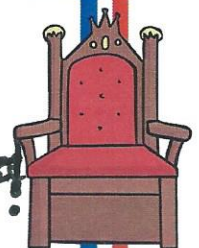
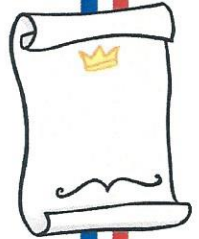
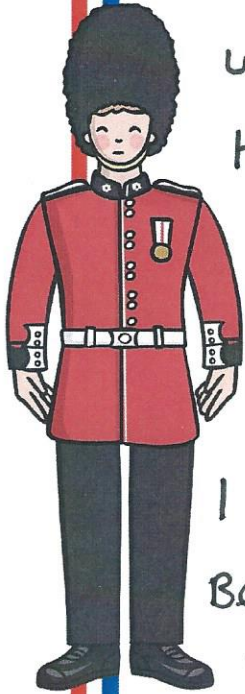
The Queen's Birthday
