Rotaract Compliance Statement 2017/18



Rotaract Great Britain and Ireland (RGBI) and Rotary International in Great Britain and Ireland (RIBI) does not seek to advise Rotaract clubs on matters of general law, but does try to help clubs to ensure that they comply with certain specific legal frameworks which are likely to apply to the regular activities of all or most Rotaract clubs.

This advice is formally provided through the RIBI Compliance Policies that cover:

- RIBI Equality and Diversity Policy
- RIBI Health and Safety Policy Statement
- RIBI Safeguarding (Children) Policy
- RIBI Safeguarding (Vulnerable Adults) Policy
- RIBI Data Protection Policy Statement

Adherence to these policies should ensure that no club inadvertently finds itself in breach of these areas of general law.

RIBI provides insurance protection for all Rotaract Clubs in the Area (Great Britain, Ireland, the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man). Insurance is provided on the basis that the Rotaract Club will operate in accordance with the RIBI Compliance Policies as well as being bound by the general law of the jurisdiction within which that club is located.

It is therefore requested that this document be signed by the Club President or Secretary on behalf of the club, thereby confirming that the Rotaract club has adopted the policies referred to above and that this compliance confirmation be returned to your *Rotary* District Secretary as soon as possible and before the 1st July 2017.
